

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE RAZOR DIRT ROCKET MX500

Safety and Warnings

- According to CPSC guidelines, the Dirt Rocket is suitable for use only by persons ages 14 years and older.
- The Dirt Rocket comes packaged with a User's Manual that contains important warranty and safety information from Razor. Before attempting to ride the Dirt Rocket, please read the User's Manual including the warranty and safety information in its entirety.
- Any person riding the Dirt Rocket is responsible (a) for purchasing and wearing helmets and any additional safety gear, including but not limited to safety gear that may be required by state and local regulations and (b) for understanding and complying with all applicable state and local laws and regulations, including but not limited to those laws and regulations related to restrictions on riding the Dirt Rocket in public areas such as roadways and sidewalks.

Return Policy

- Please see Razor USA LLC's ("Razor") return policy at <http://www.razor.com>. Note that returns to Razor are shipped at Customer's expense and must be postmarked within thirty (30) days of delivery.
- Unopened Dirt Rockets can be returned to Brookstone in accordance with Brookstone's normal return policy which can be found by [clicking here](#).
- Any returns of undamaged and non-defective units must be handled directly through Razor. Please call Razor directly at 1-866-467-2967 for full details. Razor's return policy is as follows: Razor USA LLC will only accept return of unused and undamaged Dirt Rockets that are returned in original packaging. Purchaser must follow this return procedure.
 1. Purchaser must call Razor customer service at 1-866-467-2967 with model name, serial or bar code number, and retail receipt.
 2. Purchaser must return the Dirt Rocket to Razor in an unused, undamaged condition and in the original packaging. Purchaser is responsible for the cost of shipping the Dirt Rocket back to Razor (at the address specified after calling Razor at 1-866-467-2967) and Purchaser bears the risk of loss during shipment. The Dirt Rocket must be post marked within thirty (30) days of the original delivery of the Dirt Rocket.

Warranty Information

- Razor warrants its Dirt Rockets to be free of manufacturing defects for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of purchase. This limited warranty does not cover normal wear and tear, tires, tubes, or cables nor any damage, failure or loss caused by improper assembly, maintenance, storage, or use of the Dirt Rocket. The limited warranty will be void if the Dirt Rocket is ever (a) used in a manner other than for recreation; (b) modified in any way; or (c) rented.
- No warranty on Razor's Dirt Rockets is provided directly or indirectly by Brookstone. For all warranty claims, contact Razor at 1-866-467-2967. All Warranty and/or Service work must be performed by Razor.
