

Negative Slide Scanner

VO: Hi, this is Mike at Brookstone. What I'm going to show you today is just how easy it is to save an old photo using our slide and negative scanner.

VO: All your old slides and negatives are degrading over time. Someday they won't be usable. And that'd be a shame.

VO: I've already installed the included scanner software on my PC, so now I'm just going to click the icon.

SUPER: Place slide in tray

VO: I place my negative into the tray. There's another tray for slides that works the same way.

VO: Load the tray into the scanner with the wording on the tray facing the back of the scanner. It slides in really easily.

SUPER: Click "NEGATIVE SCAN" (TBD)

VO: Then I just click the scanner icon and let the software walk me through saving the photo. I can adjust settings here if I want to make it brighter.

SUPER: Save photo to PC

VO: Ok, so there's your picture on your computer. Now you can share it or save it or whatever you like.
